Building on the path initiated five years ago, the **Women that Build Awards** continue to provide global visibility, education, and networking opportunities. They serve as a catalyst for women thrive in tech.

Women that Build Awards is one of the largest, all-encompassing recognitions for women who drive positive impact and inspire others in tech. The four previous editions garnered more than 5,000 candidates and 310.000 votes from 50 countries. As the discipline with the highest demand for future jobs, we view this as an opportunity to shape a more inclusive, diverse, and collaborative industry.

Over the four editions, global prizes included scholarships to leadership programs at prominent universities, international workshops, networking opportunities in international events and a great visibility platform that includes NYSE's Billboard at Time Square.

Our commitment: Having 50% of our management positions occupied by women and non-binary people.



The fifth edition of the Women That Build Awards aims to address persistent challenges women face in the workplace:

The <u>World Economic Forum's Global Gender Gap Report 2023</u> underscores the long road to economic gender parity.

- Only 24% women in leadership in the tech industry, being the industry that grew the most.
- Only 33% women in leadership globally (all industries)

Addressing Underrepresentation in Startups: Research indicates that women are underrepresented in startups, and this underrepresentation becomes self-reinforcing.

Closing the Funding Gap: Highlighting the <u>funding gap in Al</u> <u>companies</u>, WTB Awards aims to address the disparities by supporting and recognizing women-founded startups. The awards are committed to overcoming unconscious biases, enhancing access to networks and mentors, and promoting women's representation in technical fields to secure fair funding.
